









Four Classic Means of Revelation






Long ago, at different times and in various ways, God's voice came to our ancestors through the Hebrew prophets.

But in these last days, it has come to us through His Son, the One who has been given dominion over all things and through whom all worlds were made.






(Greek) Apaugasma Light which shines forth but is also reflected.
